### Why should I take Confined Space Rescue?

The Confined Space Rescue course is vital to anyone working in or around confined areas where:

- The space is large enough and so configured that an employee can enter and perform assigned work
- The space is not designed for continuous human occupancy
- The space has limited openings for entry/egress
- Rescue procedures would be applicable

### What will you learn in this training?

- To safely and confidently understand and evaluate the hazards and procedures associated with confined spaces
- How to differentiate between a Permit-Required confined space and a Non-Permit-Required confined space
- The hazards associated with confined spaces and outline duties of all members of a confined space entry team, emergency procedures and plan development
- The need for appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and selection characteristics for each level of protection
- The different types of direct-reading instruments, including their mode of operation and limitations
- Hands-on experience in the Confined Space Simulator
